Estonian Open Championship Kung Fu Wushu – Tuishou 2020

16 February 2020, start at 10:00





Location: Ice Hall "Tondiraba Jäähall" (Varraku 14, Tallinn, Estonia)

General Rules

The purpose of the competition:

- Determining the champions and prize winners for Kung Fu Wushu Tuishou (Pushing hands) in each weight class in each of the below mentioned categories: Fixed Step, Free Moving Step.
- 2. In each weight class champion, silver and bronze medalists are determined.
- 3. The organizing committee of the championship reserves the right to change the order of the competitions and weight classes. In the event that by the indicated deadline there is not enough submitted applications.

Weight Classes:

In the competitions the following weight classes will be used:

Male: 25kg, 30kg, 35kg, 40kg, 45kg, 50kg, 55kg, 60kg, 65kg, 70kg, 75kg, 80kg, 85kg, 90kg, 95kg, 100kg+

Female: 25kg, 30kg, 35kg, 40kg, 45kg, 50kg, 55kg, 60kg, 65kg, 70kg, 75kg, 80kg, 85kg, 90kg, 95kg, 100kg+

If there are not enough participants in one weight dass, then this weight class can be canceled or combined with another weight class. If necessary, an additional weight class can be created.

Junior participants – Participants under the age of 18 can participate in the competition only with the consent of their teachers and written permission from their parents. The participant must be at least 14 years old.

Children's Tournament

Participants under 14 years are allocated to a separate group and can participate in the competition only with the consent of their teachers and written permission of the parents. After receiving applications for participation in the tournament, weight dasses and age groups will be determined.

Competitions:

Competitions are held on the Swiss system (a circular system with some nuances). In the case of a large number of participants, the competitions will be conducted on an elimination by the Olympic system.

Award Ceremony:

Champions and prize-winners in each weight class will be awarded with medals (gold, silver and bronze) and honorary diplomas.

Participation fee: Registration fee for participants is: **€25.** The participation fee for each additional category is **€10.** Payment can be made by federations, clubs and individual participants.

For athletes from Estonia, payment must be made **no later than February 10, 2020.**

Include in the description EOMAG2020 the name of the club, sumame and name of the athlete.

Athletes from other countries must make a payment no later than February 10, 2020

Application for participation: - The participant must submit an application (registration form) for participation in the competitions **not later than February 9, 2020.** In the application, indicate your name, surname, age, weight, contact information (e-mail, phone number, address), club name or federation, team leader. The application should be sent to (<u>www.competitionbook.com</u> or <u>https://goo.gl/forms/tdw72ubK1eyhHMi83</u>)</u>

If a participant submits the application after the deadline, he is not allowed to compete.

Accreditation

The official representative of the team will receive accreditation at the time of registration.

NB! Only the original forms for participation are accepted. Documents written in a free style manner are not accepted.

NB! In case if an athlete cannot participate in competitions, it is necessary to inform the organizers about this before February 13, 2020 - artofsword@gmail.com. The entry fee of €25 is not refundable, in the case if the athlete does not inform the organizers before February 13, 2020.

Registration and weigh-in - Competition participants or team representatives must arrive to registration and receive accreditations from 9.00 - 10.00 on February 16, 2020 at the Ice Hall "Tondiraba Jäähall" (Varraku 14, Tallinn, Estonia).

Weigh-in will take place before the start of the competition on February 16, 2020 at 9.00 - 10.00, Ice Hall "Tondiraba Jäähall" (Varraku 14, Tallinn, Estonia).
